Voter (Attendee) Guide

Go to <https://StrengthThroughDiversity.life/scheduled> to register for a public servant webinar. Immediately after registering, you will receive an invitation to join the webinar.

Each webinar will have a **passcode** for entry. The webinar must be started by the **host (moderator)** before you can join, so please wait until it begins.

When you enter, Zoom will recognize you as an **attendee**. For our purposes, you will be considered a **voter seeking to make an informed choice on election day**.

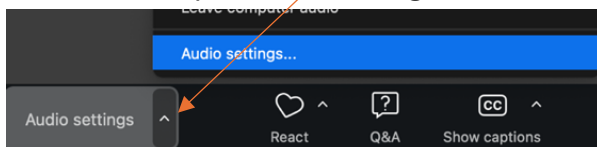
As a voter, you will not have video or microphone access during the webinar.

Below is the task bar on the bottom of the screen.

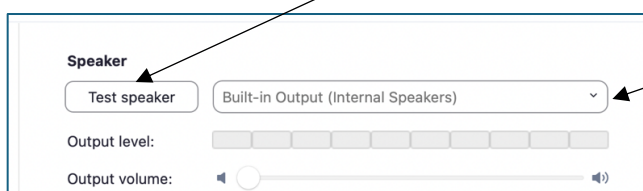


Audio Settings

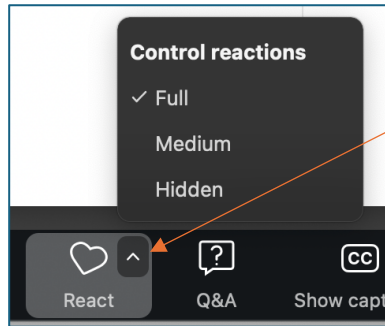
Click on the up arrow to the right of “Audio settings”.



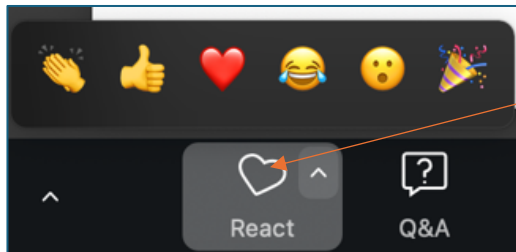
The option will appear to “Test speaker”. Choose the speaker from the drop-down menu. This is critical to hear the webinar.



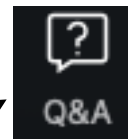
React



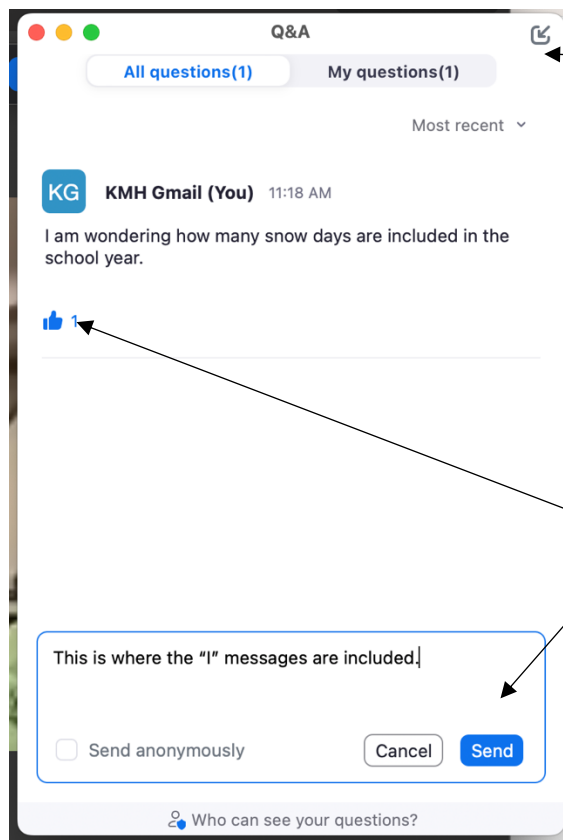
Click on the up arrow to the right of “React”. Choose how you want to see the reactions of all voters. “Full” is the emojis floating from the bottom and up. “Medium” is the emojis appearing in the bottom right of the screen. “Hidden” is no emojis appearing.



Click on the “React” heart. These are the emojis you can click on anytime during the webinar.



Submit “I” Messages for Public Servant Candidate



Next is maybe the most important. Click on the Q&A button. The square box with an arrow in it (upper-right) is to attach or detach the Q&A window to the main screen. Instead of asking questions, enter “I” messages for the public servant candidate’s response. **(Messages with “you” or “your” will be red flagged and will probably not be presented to the public servant candidate for a response.)** New messages will appear on the bottom of the Q&A window. “Like” a message from another voter. Click on the “thumbs up” icon to “upvote”. The messages with the most “upvotes” will be presented by the moderator to the public servant candidate for a response.
